LATERAL-ENTRY FIREFIGHTER/EMT

The City of Port Angeles is accepting applications for the position of Lateral-Entry Firefighter/EMT. This recruitment will be used to fill one (1) current vacancy as well as to establish an eligibility list. It is anticipated that an additional two (2) positions may be filled during the term of the list. Anyone meeting the minimum qualifications outlined below is encouraged to apply.

The City of Port Angeles Fire Department is a combination career/volunteer Department that serves a population of approximately 20,000. The Department provides a full range of fire protection services, with Emergency Medical Services accounting for the majority of the over 4,800 calls for service annually.

Lateral-Entry Firefighter/EMT

Application Period: On-going until filled. First review June 2, 2017 with initial interviews scheduled for Tuesday, June 13, 2017.

Salary DOE: \$53,659 – \$80,913 Annually

Minimum Education and Experience:

- NREMT or current Washington State EMT certification with a minimum of two (2) years' experience as an EMT. Washington State EMT required within 4 months of hire date.
- Current IFSAC/Pro Board HazMat Awareness, HazMat Operations and Firefighter I (Firefighter II desirable) certifications, with two (2) years fire service experience.
- High school diploma or GED required.
- Washington driver's license or the ability to obtain within 60 days of hire date; **must pass driving records check** and, if hired, maintain a driving record that meets the City's standard.

The process to apply for Firefighter/EMT begins with Public Safety Testing. Public Safety Testing conducts the City of Port Angeles written and physical ability examinations. Please visit their website at www.publicsafetytesting.com to select a testing date, time and location.

Following application review, qualified applicants with complete applications may be invited to the interview process. The selection process includes application screening, a one-day interview process which may include job simulation interview and oral board. Chief's interviews are conducted with top candidates. Finalist will undergo an extensive background investigation, medical and psychological assessment and drug testing. The City of Port Angeles is an Equal Employment Opportunity Employer.
